Virtus Training - All volunteers need to complete the virtus online training and complete a background check form. If you have already done this you do not need to do it again. Please let me know if you have any questions about this.

School Hours - Drop off is from 8:00-8:15. The bell rings at 8:15 for students to enter their classrooms. Dismissal is at 11:30 for half days and 3:20 for full days. There is only one dismissal time. A separate email with drop off/ pick up procedures to follow.

Parking Lot Supervision – To ensure the safety of our children, students <u>must</u> have adult supervision on our parking lot. The morning parking lot supervisors will be on duty beginning at 8:00 each morning. If you need to drop your student(s) off before 8AM please contact Dru Densmore, our Latch Key director. **Please have children remain in your vehicle until a parking lot supervisor is visible.** Children who are not picked up by 3:40 will be taken to Latch Key and charged a fee.

Latch Key News – Latchkey will begin with both the morning and afternoon session, on the first full day of school, Wednesday, August 21. A separate email with all the pertinent details will be going out to all registered Latchkey families the first week of August. FACTS Parent Alert is a communications system used by SJS to send email, voice, and text message blasts to all parents. An email with the attached weekly newsletter is sent out at 4:00 on Thursdays. This weekly communication contains important school information. A 4:00 Sunday afternoon email is sent most weeks with reminders for the upcoming week. Please make sure to scroll all the way down for newsletters because there are typically flyers to view.

Free and Reduced Lunch Assistance Benefits Our School! — The federal government provides assistance to families who qualify for free or reduced lunch. Application forms will be available at the Family Open House, are on hand in our school office and available for download on our website at https://www.jcsstjohn.org/parents. The application process and all information is completely confidential and qualifying students use the same process for lunch purchase as everyone else so it's all very discreetly handled. Mrs. Kaiser receives federal money for each student who qualifies, to help supplement our hot lunch program. In addition to this, Title 1 funding, which provides reading and math assistance for some of our students, is also affected by the number of students who qualify for free or reduced lunch. I encourage you to take advantage of this beneficial program.
