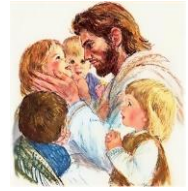




St. John Catholic School

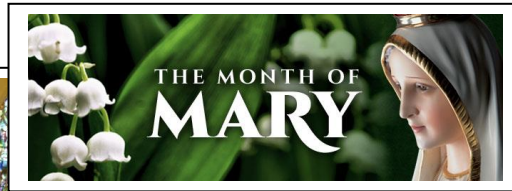
